The Match Committee, therefore request that Clubs submit their team registrations to WGI by 4:00pm on Friday, 22 July 2016. The team members do not need to be named at this time. WGI also welcomes entries from new teams, and asks that the team registration form be completed with an indication of the likely level of playing ability of the team (in terms of average Handicap).
