SHAND CUP AND SALVER

Participating Associations:

Manawatu / Wanganui, Taranaki, Wellington, and Hawke's Bay District Golf Associations.

History:

The Shand Cup was donated in 1965 by Messrs J.R and R.S. Shand of Palmerston North, for Inter-Association competition between the Hawke's Bay, Manawatu-Wanganui, Taranaki and Wellington Golf Associations. The first event was held at the Manawatu Golf Club in 1966. The Shand Salver, for Junior competition, was presented by the same donors and was first played for in 1977.

Rules:

1. Amendments:

- a. These rules may only be amended by the following procedure:
- b. A notice of motion clearly stating the proposed change must be sent to each participating Association not later than three months following a Shand Cup and Salver event.

Notices of motion shall be decided by postal vote unless only one Association objects to this procedure. In the event of such objection, a meeting shall be arranged with two representatives from each Association present. The meeting shall elect a chairman who will have a deliberative vote, but no casting vote. Any majority in voting shall decide the notice of motion but if the voting is equal, then the existing Rule or Rules shall stand unaltered.

2. Venue:

The tournament shall be held each year on a top grade course in each Association's area in turn, with the venue for the following year decided by that Association and confirmed at each year's Managers' meeting. If in any year an Association cannot provide a course then, by mutual consent, the event shall be allocated to another Association's course.

3. Managers' Meeting:

The meeting shall be convened by the host Association which will be responsible for recording the meeting and forwarding a copy of the minutes to each participating Association as soon as possible afterwards. The function of the Managers' meeting shall be to discuss and agree upon points relating to local rules and the organization of that year's tournament. While it is appropriate that the meeting discuss condition of the tournament and make recommendations, the Rules may be changed only as outlined in 1(2) above. Representatives of Club's committee should be present to explain Local Rules and other arrangements.

4. Minute Book:

A special Shand Cup and Salver Minute book shall be kept at the office of the Secretary of the Manawatu-Wanganui Golf Association. The minute book shall be available at each year's Managers' meeting and returned to the Secretary immediately afterwards in the custody of the Manager of the Manawatu-Wanganui Golf Association team. The minute book shall contain all the information regarding past Shand Cup venues, results, minutes of Managers' meetings and any alterations to the rules.

5. Administration:

The administration of the Shand Cup and Salver and the recording of the minutes shall be the responsibility of the host Association. The Secretary of the Manawatu-Wanganui Golf Association shall be responsible for conducting postal votes on alterations to the rules etc.

6. Expenses:

Each Association is responsible for its own expenditure on accommodation, travel and meals. The cost of any complimentary meals is borne by the host Association.

Conditions of play:

1. Teams:

A senior team of ten players of unrestricted ages will contest the Shand Cup, and an Age Group team of four Juniors will contest the Shand Salver, The Junior Age Group team shall comprise of 4 players under the age of 19 years as at the first day of scheduled play of the tournament for that year.

2. Entries:

The names of team members, in playing order, are to be advised to the host Secretary by 5.00pm on the Monday preceding the tournament.

3. Draw:

The host Association is to prepare a seeded draw based on the preceding year's finishing order in the Shand Cup and forward it immediately to the participating Associations by fax or post. The competition is to be played over three rounds of 18 holes with two rounds on Saturday and one round on Sunday morning.

4. Competition:

- **a.** Each team plays one match of singles against each of the other teams.
- b. The winning team is determined by the greatest number of team wins. In the event of a tie, the result is decided by the greatest number of individual wins or points. If ties remain, the trophies are held jointly.

- c. An individual win counts one point to the team and a match finishing all square counts half a point to each team.
- d. The playing order of teams may be changed for the third round only. A copy of the revised playing order must be with the Secretary of the host Association not later than 6pm on the Saturday.
- e. If a member of a team becomes unable to play, owing to illness, injury or other sufficient cause, he may be replaced as follows: up until 1pm on the Friday prior to the event, a replacement player may be positioned at No. 10 (at No. 4 in the Salver), and all other players move up one place. After 1pm on the Friday, a replacement may only take place of the player being replaced.
- f. Play shall be in fours and in reverse playing order with the Shand Salver preceding the Shand Cup and each member of each team starting from the same tee in a particular round.
- g. The Rules and Disputes Committee shall be appointed by the host Association and consist of two members holding NZGA Referees badges. The Committee's decision shall be final in all cases.

Rules updated September 2006

SYBIL GREEN SALVER

Participating Associations:

Manawatu / Wanganui, Taranaki, Wellington, and Hawke's Bay District Golf Associations.

History:

The Sybil Green Salver was presented in 1985 by Sybil Green, a Wanganui Golf Club member, to foster golf of a national match play level in four districts.

Traditionally the Sybil Green was to be played only in the Manawatu Wanganui district and only on the Wanganui and Manawatu Golf Club Courses. In 2010 the Women's committee for the Manawatu Wanganui agreed to play the same venue as the men's Shand Cup & Salver.

Rules:

- 1. Matches will be played under the same conditions as the "Interprovincial Tournament"
- 2. Teams to consist of 8 members and a non-playing Captain.
- 3. Two rounds on Saturday and one round on Sunday.
- 4. Play will be in 4's
- 5. To be played annually, and staged alternately in rotation around the four districts
- 6. Each District will be responsible for their accommodation and travel arrangements
- 7. Should the tournament cease to be held, the trophy will be held by the Manawatu/Wanganui Women's Golf Committee.
- 8. The draw for the matches for the Sybil Green will match that of the Shand Cup.
